TRTI, Pune has published limited e-Tender through mahatenders.gov.in on 11.02.2026 for evaluation and impact assessment of three schemes separately. Since, all the expected bidders are from the Empanelment of Planning Department, GoM, and the nature of work/project is same, the pre-bid meeting for these three tenders was scheduled on 18.02.2026 at 4.00 PM physically at TRTI, Pune. Some of the bidders requested the pre-bid meeting in virtual mode which was accepted and the meeting was conducted in hybrid mode on 18.02.2026 at 4.00 pm. For this meeting, representative of one bidder was present physically and representatives of other bidders joined virtually.

The queries for all three tenders were discussed in the meeting. The queries raised by the bidder/bidder's representatives were clarified in the meeting. The clarifications on the queries are placed as below. These pre-bid meeting minutes should be treated as a part of the above said RFPs and shall be binding on bidders for the three RFPs under reference.

4	7	Socio-economic change	It was requested to specify the expected % change in income so that the sample size can be adequately proposed.	The % change in income generally expected 20-40%. This has been broadly specified. Higher than this would be appreciated.
5	8	Payment Terms	It was requested to give payment of at least 10 % on signing of the contract.	This request is accepted and 10 % of sanctioned amount (incl.GST) will be paid after signing of contract. (i.e.after completion of Phase I) and 20 % amount of sanctioned amount (inc.GST) will be paid after completion of Phase II. Payment conditions after completion of Phase II and IV will be same as mentioned in RFP.
6	8, 10, 11	Regarding ratio in QCBS	It was requested by one bidder to change the ratio from 70:30 to 80:20	It was decided not to change the ratio i.e.the ratio for QCBS will be 70:30.
7	10	RFP	Is there a suggested page limit for the technical proposal?	No. It should give clear picture of the points exactly expected and evaluated.
8	--	Financial cap	It was asked whether there is any financial cap for bidding.	The bidders are expected to give appropriate financial bid in line with the proposed approach, sampling plan etc.
